

MUTA GRANTS

The Marysville Unified Teachers' Association is happy to help individual students and school groups reach for their educational goals. The purpose of our grants is to further academic achievement and develop civic responsibility within students in the Marysville Unified School District.

Grants can be given to individuals or clubs at a high school site. The grant must be used within the academic year of the award and for the purpose it was intended on this application.

Grants will be awarded in the amount of \$100 to individuals and \$500 to groups. The total allocation is \$1000 per MJUSD high school per school year -- please recognize this grant will be allocated on a first come, first serve basis. If a club is granted funds for an activity, individual members will not be able to request money for the same purpose. Applying for a grant is not a guarantee of funds. Once the \$1000 is dispersed per school, no more funds will be available until the following school year.

Please send your application to The Marysville Unified Teachers' Association in care of Debra Warner, Scholarship Chair, at least two months prior to the date funds are required.
